Mueller named CEO of Valley Vision

SACRAMENTO – Bill Mueller will take over the top slot of Valley Vision, a local nonprofit group that deals with regional and quality of life issues, a press release announced Tuesday.

Mueller, who became a managing partner for the group about two years ago, will take over as CEO on Jan. 14, the release said.

Valley Vision's previous CEO, Susan Frazier, announced her resignation in November, citing a desire to work on other regional issues, the release said.

Mueller joined the organization in the summer 2005 after five years with Intel, the release said.

He is a graduate of California State University, Sacramento.

Valley Vision operates with a budget of \$1.3 million and partners with many business, agriculture and environmental groups, organized labor, government, schools and other nonprofit groups.
