

## Sacramento ranks No. 25 in U.S. for jobs

The Sacramento-Arden Arcade-Roseville area ranks No. 25 among the nation's best metropolitan areas for jobs, according to a ranking released by Forbes.com. But that's down 11 notches from last year's No. 14 ranking, according to the magazine's "Best Cities for Jobs" list.

The magazine ranked the top 100 metropolitan areas, using five criteria: unemployment rate, job growth, income growth, median household income and cost of living.

Sacramento scored low in both cost of living and unemployment, but ranked No. 21 nationwide in job growth and income growth.

The top three cities were Raleigh-Cary, N.C.; Phoenix-Mesa-Scottsdale, Ariz.; and Jacksonville, Fla. The worst city was Detroit-Livonia-Dearborn, Mich.
