

Purpose of Webinar


- Enhance understanding of implementation strategies through the Salinas Inclusive Economic Development Initiative

Overview: CERF Objectives

- Support the development of meaningfully inclusive regional planning processes that produce regional roadmaps for economic development efforts that prioritize the creation of accessible, highquality jobs in sustainable industries.
- Invest in projects proposed by regional planning tables that align with regional strategies and meet criteria for equity, job quality, and sustainability, among others.

 Align and leverage state investments (e.g., High Road Training Partnerships, community capacity building programs), federal investments (e.g., Infrastructure Investment and Jobs Act), and philanthropic and private-sector investments in regions to maximize economic development efforts.

Catalyst Fund Update - Sneak Preview

- \$14 million per region to bridge inclusive economic planning and project and program implementation:
 - Up to \$2 million in HRTC (Collaborative) Operations
 - Up to \$1.5 million towards Sector Investment Coordinators
 - Up to \$9 million for project pre-development activities
 - Up to \$1.5 million towards grant administration and compliance (fiscal agent overhead)
- **\$268 million** statewide will be available for project implementation


