<p>Discussion Summary Who do we need to reach out to and how?</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● Single Parents <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>○ After School programs</li> <li>○ Orgs that serve low-income parents</li> <li>○ Universal preschool</li> <li>○ Many of us have personal relationships with them or run into them through daily activities (i.e. going to Starbucks, to the grocery store, etc)</li> </ul> </li> <li>● ESL</li> <li>● Veterans</li> <li>● The Unhoused <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>○ How do we move them forward when they don't have things like documentation?</li> <li>○ There was a survey that went out and one of the things that came through was where do the unhoused put their things when attending school so they're not carrying things around with them? Will be building lockers</li> <li>○ Unhoused students are underreported</li> </ul> </li> <li>● Those who don't have a college education</li> <li>● Youth (those under 25)</li> <li>● Retirees on fixed income experiencing the effects of an increased cost of living. Often may be scared to reach out due to pride or being fearful that they will be taken away from what they know</li> <li>● Children in foster care</li> <li>● Commuters from Yuba City and Marysville because they can't afford to live here</li> <li>● Multicultural workers</li> </ul>	<p>1.</p>
